### **Reading of Scripture**

Hebrews 3:7-19 (ESV) <sup>7</sup>Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says,

"Today, if you hear his voice,

<sup>8</sup> do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion,

on the day of testing in the wilderness,

<sup>9</sup> where your fathers put me to the test

and saw my works for forty years.

<sup>10</sup> Therefore I was provoked with that generation,

and said, 'They always go astray in their heart;

they have not known my ways.'

<sup>11</sup> As I swore in my wrath,

'They shall not enter my rest.' "

<sup>12</sup> Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. <sup>13</sup> But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin. <sup>14</sup> For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end. <sup>15</sup> As it is said,

"Today, if you hear his voice,

do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion."

<sup>16</sup> For who were those who heard and yet rebelled? Was it not all those who left Egypt led by Moses? <sup>17</sup> And with whom was he provoked for forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose bodies fell in the wilderness? <sup>18</sup> And to whom did he swear that they would not enter his rest, but to those who were disobedient? <sup>19</sup> So we see that they were unable to enter because of unbelief. **Sermon,** Rev.
